

2023 ANAHEIM TRIP May 26-29, 2023

OVERVIEW

The Symphonic Band biannual performance trip to Anaheim is happening on Memorial Day weekend in May 2023. We will have the opportunity to participate in clinics, workshops, and performances at a Heritage Music Festival as well as Disneyland! While this is a great opportunity for the bands the trip will only be possible if all or most band members (with a balanced instrumentation) are able to attend this trip. Please read through the information below to see if this trip will be possible for your family. **We need a commitment to attend by Friday, September 2**nd.

COST: \$725 (per student)

ECHS Bands has committed \$12,000 toward this trip and is reflected in this cost. Beyond this contribution there will be no fundraisers available for this trip, however the \$12,000 the program is committing toward this trip comes from our concerts and Play-a-thon fundraisers, which means we need your support at well as the communities to hit this target.

CHAPERONES

Not all interested parents will be able to attend this trip as a chaperone. Chaperones will not be selected on a first-come first-served basis. Criteria for chaperone selection will include, but not limited to, previous experience on overnight band trips, nursing and/or medical experience, fingerprint clearance from WCCUSD, and the ability to work well with the director. Two (2) chaperones will be assigned to one hotel room and all chaperones must fly or ride on the same flights/bus as the band. Chaperones must be "on duty" the entire length of the trip.

Chaperone duties include, but are not limited to:

- Monitoring student activities
- Meeting with students at designated times of the day and reporting to the director
- Assisting the director with student behavior problems
- Taking shifts at night to ensure students do not leave their hotel rooms
- Helping students that feel ill or need to stay at hotel for illness other injury
- Reporting any behavioral issues and problems to the director
